Semester and Registration Dates	The Fall semester begins August 19 and ends on December 6. The campus closes during Christmas and New Year's holidays. The Spring semester begins January 6 and ends on April 24. There are no on-ground, traditional classes during the summer break-all classes offered are in online format.

Application Deadline	The deadlines for submitting a full application are June 20 for the Fall semester and September 20 for the Spring semester. You will then be contacted by the International Programs office of Shorter University to discuss the rest of the enrollment process.
