- **PUNISHMENT AND SOCIETY (CRIM 138-80-77281)**

Fall 2024: October-December 2024

In-depth examination of sentencing philosophies in the US; critical assessment of historical shifts and current developments in aims of sentencing; analysis of the impact on convicted offenders and society.

- **CRIMINAL LEGAL PROCESS (CRIM 117-80-77241)**

Fall 2024: October-December 2024

Specific emphasis on the laws of arrest, search and seizure, interrogation and confession, procedure prior to and during trial, postconviction procedures, limitations on criminal prosecutions and juvenile proceedings.

Classes are held online (via Zoom).

Registration: Students can register for the courses once they have received a permission number from Dr. Schweizer. This is done after determining the applicant's eligibility for the program.

Cost: The cost for a course is \$915. There are no other fees, except for any textbooks that may be required by the instructor.

Payment information: Payment for courses can be made via credit card or online electronic bank transfer at the time of course registration. Payment has to be made in some form either at the time of course registration or within 24 hours of registering, or the course registration is voided.

NEW COMPONENT FOR STUDENTS IN FOREIGN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

This program was designed to deliver academic instruction to students already working in, or retired from, criminal justice related organizations, and who cannot attend regularly scheduled classes designed for the resident student population.



COURSE OFFERINGS

- Total of **49 or more semester units**, which satisfy the upper division course requirements for a bachelor of science in Criminology, with a focus on Law Enforcement.
- Each course is taught either **via Zoom, asynchronously, synchronously**, and or **Hybrid**. Nearly all faculty teaching in the program are tenured or tenure track professors.



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PARTICIPATION

To facilitate the interaction and exchange of experiences between students in foreign educational institutions, and officers and employees of American criminal justice related organizations, the program is offering such foreign students the opportunity to register for any courses in the program, with the issuance of a special certificate after the completion of four courses offered by the program.

Individual courses are taught over a two months period, and four courses are offered each spring and fall. The material and instruction in each course is the equivalent of 45 hours of instruction, not including final examinations. The cost for each course is \$930, not including any supplemental material that may be required by the course instructor.
